

Addendum 2 to the Regulations on admission, enrolment and deregistration at Zuyd University of Applied Sciences 2023–2024

Brief explanation

This addendum supplements the Regulations on admission, enrolment and deregistration at Zuyd University of Applied Sciences 2023–2024, version 0.3, dated August 2022, and was adopted by the Executive Board on 23 May 2023 after having obtained the approval of the Central Participation Council on 6 June 2023.

Supplement to:

CHAPTER 6 TUITION FEES AND EXAMINATION FEES

Article 6.7 Further provisions with regard to tuition fees and examination fees

Paragraph 4 Non-funded study programme Joint Master LHI

Students of the non-funded study programme Joint Master LHI must pay 50% of their tuition fees when they enrol. They must pay the remaining 50% by 31 December of the first year of enrolment.

Article 6.9 No reimbursement of tuition fees or examination fees

Paragraph 5 Non-funded study programme Joint Master LHI

Students who deregister from the non-funded study programme Joint Master LHI will not have their tuition fees reimbursed in full.

Students who are nationals of an EEA member country and deregister before 30 September of the first year of enrolment will have their tuition fees reimbursed, less the sum of €2,500 to cover the administrative costs of the three partner institutions. Students who deregister between 30 September and 31 January of the first year of enrolment will have 50% of the total tuition fees due reimbursed.

Students who are nationals of a country outside the EEA and who deregister before 31 January of the first year of enrolment due to special and/or personal circumstances will have 50% of the total tuition fees due reimbursed. Claims for special and/or personal circumstances are subject to the approval of the dean and the head of programme. Students are advised to discuss this in advance with the dean, who will inform the head of programme.
