Requirements for nomination

- The person you nominate is an inspiring example for others within Zuyd.
- You nominate this student or employee and clearly explain why this person deserves to be nominated for this award.
- There must be social impact and a contribution to (one of) the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
